

#### **Telling it Right in 2023**

After a bit of a break over the Christmas holidays Up on Downs got back in the saddle and kick started the year by submitting information to the Strategic Inequalities review into Maternity Services via the Voluntary, Community, Faith and Social Enterprise (VCFSE) Alliance. It is hoped that our views, along with other voices from the VCFSE can help to shape improvements in the NHS Integrated Care System (ICS) that oversees our loved one's care.

Whilst our events and speech classes will always be the most important outreach, and forms the core to the work that benefits our member families, there is also a lot of behind the scenes work that we do to help advocate for the community. We do this via forums such as the VCFSE Alliance and through partnership meetings with organisations such as HPCI and the NHCVS.

#### What can we do for you in 2023?

Last year we introduced our lovely feedback cards which had easy choose options but also offered the opportunity for more detailed feedback. These cards were put to good use getting feedback from the Choices Teens and their parent carers.

The cards allowed us to gather great feedback which we then put to good use helping us secure a 2nd round of funding for Choices. It also offered up wonderful ideas which will help us to deliver a programme that is varied and makes use of our young people's interests.


