## Speech Development Programme Spaces Available

Saturday mornings during term time London Colney, Welwyn Garden City and Hitchin

Up on Downs has provided a Speech Development programme for children with Down's syndrome for over ten years. We work with three specialist Symbol trained co-workers who work out of sites in London Colney, Welwyn Garden City and Hitchin. The sessions bring together



children of similar ability in small groups to focus on fun tasks to develop speech sounds in our younger children moving on to working on social communication and clarity in our older children and teens.



The programme comprises of nine sessions per term, delivered on Saturday mornings at each of the three sites. We currently have space within the programme to take on new children and would like to hear from any families who would be interested in a place for their child.
